RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 19

Adopting Projects for the Draft FY 2016-19 Transportation Improvement Program

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by MAP-21 Sections 1201 and 1202, July 2012); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan Planning Organizations are required under 23 CFR 450.324, in support of the Long Range Transportation Plan, to develop and approve a short-range, four-year work program, consisting of projects or phases of projects that are completely funded and can be constructed within the four-year cycle; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Transportation, in concurrence with the Federal Highway Administration, has directed the MPO, in the absence of an adopted FY2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program, to develop and approve project listings that may be approved for funding and construction by those agencies until such time that formal 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan and FY 2016-19 Transportation Improvement Plan development may be completed; and

WHEREAS, the following projects have been approved by the ESMPO to add to the ALDOT Comprehensive Project Management System (CPMS) prior to inclusion in the Draft FY 2016-19 Transportation Improvement Program:

- **City of Daphne** – Gator Alley - North Main Street at D'Olive Creek - Southeast of I- 10 at US 98/90 exchange at D'Olive Creek; Turnout/Overlook/Drainage/Scenic Improvements. **Estimated Cost:** \$400,094.
- **Baldwin County** – U.S. 98 from CR13 to SR 181; Barnwell Community; construction of 1.53 miles sidewalks. **Estimated Cost:** \$385,405.00
- **City of Spanish Fort** – CR 72 from US 31 to SR 225; Construction of 1.2 miles sidewalks. **Estimated Cost:** \$439,576.09

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, having reviewed and approved the foregoing, does hereby adopt these projects for development and construction, subject to approval by the Alabama Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration.

The foregoing resolution was adopted and approved on the 23rd day of October, 2013, by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board.
