### **RESOLUTION NO.** 2014-03

## Approving Projects for Inclusion in the Draft 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by MAP-21 Sections 1201 and 1202, July 2012); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, 23 CFR 450.322 requires Metropolitan Planning Organizations to develop a long range transportation plan with a minimum twenty-year planning horizon, to be updated a minimum of every four years, be multimodal and function as a single integrated transportation network, and be available to the public and interested parties for review and comment prior to approval by the MPO according to the provisions of 23 CFR 450.316(a); and

WHEREAS, the following projects have been approved for inclusion in the Draft 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan:

#### City of Spanish Fort

Blakeley Way, from US 31 to SR 225; Widening, resurfacing and drainage improvements

#### City of Fairhope

- Downtown Fairhope; Construction of Public Transit Shelter
- US 98 and SR 104, from Rock Creek Parkway to Section Street; Construction of 2.12 mile of 8foot-wide multi-use path
- Fairhope Avenue at Ingleside Street; Construction of intersection roundabout
- Volanta Ave, from Section Street to US 98; Milling and resurfacing
- Young St, from 0.8 miles north of CR 44 to Morphy Avenue; Milling and resurfacing
- Ingleside St, from Fairhope Avenue to Gayfer Avenue; Milling and resurfacing
- SR 181, from Quail Creek Dr. to .25 miles south of CR 48; construction of .40 miles of sidewalk and pedestrian crosswalk with push signals at the intersection of CR48 and SR181.

#### **ALDOT**

- I-10, from Baldwin County line to US 98; Adding additional lanes
- US 31, from Westminster Drive to SR 181; Adding additional lanes
- SR 181, from SR 64 to SR 104; Adding additional lanes
- SR 181, from SR 104 to CR 32; Adding additional lanes
- SR 181, from CR 32 to US 98; Adding additional lanes
- I-10, from US 98 to SR 181; Adding additional lanes; now

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, having reviewed and approved the foregoing, does hereby adopt the listed projects for inclusion in the Eastern Shore MPO Draft 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan Visionary/Needs Project List.
