Adopting the 2014 Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation Concept

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by MAP-21 Sections 1201 and 1202, July 2012); 42 USC 2000d, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration issued guidance in June 2009 and March 2010 establishing requirements for bicycle and pedestrian improvements to federally funded highways in Alabama; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to those federal agency directives, the Alabama Department of Transportation instructed the MPOs to prepare Bicycle and Pedestrian Plans as MPO formal planning documents and submit those plans for review and approval; and


WHEREAS, consistent with the declaration of these provisions, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Planning Staff, in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation, has prepared a Final Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization 2014 Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation Concept;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) adopts the Final Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization 2014 Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation Concept.
