Adopt the Draft Eastern Shore 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)

WHEREAS, consistent with the declaration of these provisions, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation, has prepared a Draft Eastern Shore 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its duties, functions, and responsibilities, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, in session this 22nd day of April, 2015, did review and evaluate the aforementioned Draft Eastern Shore 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan, summarized on the attached pages; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization that the same does hereby endorse and adopt said Draft Eastern Shore 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan.
