RESOLUTION NO. 2016-15

Amending the FY 2016 to 2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the FAST Act, Sections 1201 and 1202, December 2015); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, Title 23 USC 134 and 23 CFR 450.324 require that transportation projects in urbanized areas, funded by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration, be included in a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), amended as often as required, and adopted by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, consistent with the declaration of these provisions, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation, has prepared an FY 2016 to 2019 Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board adopted Resolution 2015-24 approving the Final FY 2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program; and


WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Transportation and Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board have proposed changes to the Final FY 2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program including project CN – 10065553; and

WHEREAS, The City of Daphne and the Baldwin Regional Area Transit systems wish to construct a transit hub using MPO Transit funds; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its duties, functions, and responsibilities, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, did review and evaluate the aforementioned changes to the Transportation Improvement Program, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, has reviewed the Amended FY 2016 to 2019 Transportation Improvement Program and does hereby approve the said amendment as attached.
