RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 11

**Approving Modifications to the Visionary/Needs List of the
2040 Long Range Transportation Plan**

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by MAP-21 Sections 1201 and 1202, July 2012); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, 23 CFR 450.322 requires Metropolitan Planning Organizations to develop a long range transportation plan with a minimum twenty-year planning horizon, to be updated a minimum of every four years, be multimodal and function as a single integrated transportation network, and be available to the public and interested parties for review and comment prior to approval by the MPO according to the provisions of 23 CFR 450.316(a); and

WHEREAS, the following projects have been approved for inclusion in the Draft 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan:

ALDOT

- Alabama State Veterans Memorial Cemetery Signs on I-10
- Baldwin Beach Express Signage at SR 59 Interchange
- Fiber Lease Agreement – Adaptive Signal Project Phase I

Baldwin County


- Resurfacing Scenic 98 from Nelson Dr. to CR 1
- Widening and Resurfacing CR 13 from SR 104 to CR 48/CR 64 and CR 13 round-a-bout to Ottawa Dr.

City of Daphne

- Intersection Improvements on CR 13 at Sehoj Blvd. and Long Vue Dr.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, having reviewed and approved the foregoing, does hereby adopt the listed project for inclusion in the Eastern Shore MPO Draft 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan Visionary/Needs Project List.
