Adopting the 2022 Title VI Plan

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the FAST Act, Sections 1201 and 1202, December 2015); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, the MPO is the recipient of Section 5307 Urbanized Area Transit funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA);

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and FTA Circular 4702.1B that all recipients, including subrecipients, of federal transit funding prepare a Title VI Program to be approved by the recipient's board or directors or appropriate governing entity;

WHEREAS, the MPO Policy Board is the governing entity of the Eastern Shore MPO;

WHEREAS, this Title VI Program is applicable only to the Eastern Shore MPO and is not applicable the MPO member governments unless specified under a Memorandum of Understanding; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby approves the MPO Title VI Program in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and FTA Circular 4702.1B.
