MPO Staff Retitles

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Section 11201, November 2021); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, the Daphne-Fairhope-Foley metro area was the seventh fastest growing metro area in the United States from 2010-2020;

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) has increased planning requirements creating additional complexities and responsibilities for MPO staff; and


WHEREAS, MPO staffs throughout the state consist of Directors and Transportation Planners; now

- MPO Coordinator retitled to MPO Director
- Administrative Support Specialist III retitled to Transportation Planner

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the reclassifications are contingent upon approval by the Baldwin County Commission as the Administrator of the Eastern Shore MPO.
