RESOLUTION NO. 2025-03

Highway Functional Classification Changes

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Section 11201, November 2021); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the federal regulations referenced above, both the State of Alabama and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) require Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) to establish a Highway Functional Classification (HFC) Network within the Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore MPO Policy Board previously adopted the HFC Network and Map through Resolution 2013-09; and

WHEREAS, to ensure continued accuracy and efficiency, MPO staff has recommended updates and adjustments to the roadway classifications within the HFC Network and Map; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board has reviewed the proposed roadway classification changes, as detailed in the attached list/map, and hereby approves and supports the recommended revisions.

The foregoing resolution was adopted and approved on this 29th day of January, 2025, by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board.
