**Adopting the Baldwin Regional Area Transit System (BRATS) Public
Transportation Agency Safety Plan (PTASP)**

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Section 11201, November 2021); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and


WHEREAS, 49 CFR 673 require that public transit agencies adopt a Safety Plan in accordance with the 5311 and 5307 grant requirements of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT); and

WHEREAS, ALDOT offered to develop the plan on behalf of local agencies and Baldwin Regional Area Transit System (BRATS) opted into the process and has been an active participant in the development of this plan by sharing existing documentation and participating in communication and coordination throughout the development; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission approved the updated Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan (PTASP) on January 20, 2026; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization has reviewed the PTASP and hereby approves the aforementioned plan.
