RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11

Adopting Final 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Section 11201, November 2021); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

WHEREAS, Title 23 USC 135 and 23 CFR 450.324 require that transportation projects in urbanized areas, funded by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration, be derived from a Long Range Transportation Plan adopted by vote of the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, consistent with the declaration of these provisions, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), has prepared the Final 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, has reviewed the Final 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan and does hereby adopt said 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan.

The foregoing resolution was adopted and approved on the 28th day of January 2026, by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board.
